Call Meeting to Order

Chair Charlotte McGuire called the meeting to order at 9:56 AM.

Approval of March Meeting Minutes

Kirsten Hill made a motion to approve the March 2019 meeting minutes, Meryl Johnson seconded the motion. Chair Charlotte McGuire called for a voice vote. The minutes were approved.

OAC Rule 3301-51-11 Preschool Children Eligible for Special Education

Staff presented proposed revisions to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3301-51-11 Preschool Children Eligible for Special Education. The rule is being revised for the five-year rule review and to align with a change in Ohio Revised Code. Board members discussed the outstanding concerns raised by stakeholders and staff shared information in response. During the discussion, Committee members proposed, discussed and agreed to two additional revisions to the rule: 1) Eliminate the words “in the following order” from paragraph in paragraph (J)(2); and 2) Restore originally posted language in paragraph (J)(1), which does not include a time or mileage limit for the inclusive preschool program list. Meryl Johnson made a motion to approve the resolution to recommend adoption of the rule as amended, Kirsten Hill seconded. Chair Charlotte McGuire called for a voice vote. Motion approved. The rule will go to the state board of education for adoption in May.

Social and Emotional Learning Standards

Staff provided an update on the public comment feedback received as of the committee meeting date on the Social and Emotional Learning Standards and reviewed the anticipated timeline for committee action. Board members discussed the roles of school personnel and families and the supports needed for implementation.

The committee will continue discussion of the Social and Emotional Learning Standards in May with a possible vote to recommend adoption.

Board Member Johnson’s Proposed Resolution

Members discussed Board Member Johnson’s proposed resolution related to the use of Native American Mascots and how several districts have addressed at the local level.

Meryl Johnson moved to advance the resolution to the state board for adoption. Mark Lamoncha seconded. Chair Charlotte McGuire called a roll-call vote. Voting “Yes” –



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Meryl Johnson, Antoinette Miranda and Mark Lamoncha. Voting “No” – Martha Manchester, Charlotte McGuire and Kirsten Hill. The motion was lost.
