Agriculture Education 5th Quarter Competitive Grant Application

Summary:

Provide an overview of the guidance, purpose, and submission for the Agriculture Education 5th Quarter Grant.

Description:

The Agriculture Education 5th Quarter Grant is a state-funded grant targeting yearround instruction. It was developed to assist local schools and career centers provide supplemental resources to ensure delivery of summer instruction and to develop student entrepreneurial activity and work-based learning experience through organized supervised agricultural experience (SAE). The funds provide additional revenue streams for local education agencies (LEAs) to assist them in providing the Agriculture Education 5th Quarter goal of year-round instruction and data collection to validate student work-based learning experiences, income and efficiency factors related to SAEs.

Requirements:

Only LEAs that are committed to summer instructional activities with direct supervision of students by their teachers of agriculture may apply. The LEA must demonstrate a need for the funds and produce a complete proposal in Comprehensive Continuous Improvement Plan (CCIP) that meets the aims and purposes of the funds. Funding for the grant begins July 1, 2020 and runs through June 30, 2021. Successful applicants may receive grant funding for FY2021. Agriculture Education 5th Quarter Grants are subject to the state biennium budget approval.

Dates:

Competitive Grant Applications for the Agriculture Education 5th Quarter Grant FY2021 open Monday, May 4, 2020 and shall close Monday, June 22, 2020 at 5:00 PM EST. Grants shall be Authorized Representative Approved on or before the application close date to be considered for funding.
