Important Message for 2020-2021 Overrides

The CTE teacher licensure override process is being overhauled for the 2020-2021 school year. Please review your district's CTE FTE, Staff Error Detail and CTE Approved Overrides reports in the Data Collector over the coming weeks to determine if your CTE courses need an override. Qualifying teachers that completed the Middle School Validation course and submitted the Middle School Validation application and followed the Middle School Validation instructions will not need an override this year. Project Lead the Way teachers that we have on file, will also be automated this year. If your teacher still gets an error on your Error Detail Report, make sure you have a certificate on file for your teacher and submit that with your override request.
