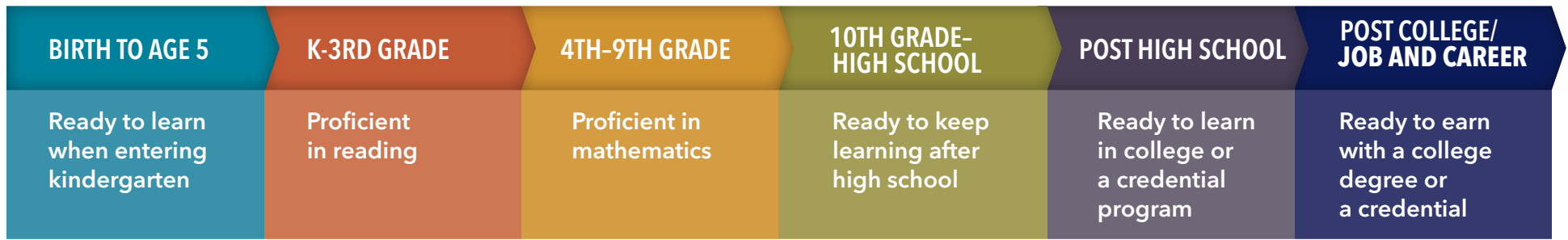


The BIG GOAL:

Increase the percentage of adults in the Dayton Region who have a college degree or post-secondary credential to 60% by 2025.
The current percentage of college graduates in Montgomery County is 36%.

By 2025, increase to 50% the number of high-school students who are securing a 2- or 4-year degree within 6 years of graduation.
The current percentage is 38%.
