



Updates and Enhancements

Below is a summary of changes made to the OhioMeansJobs K-12 website since launching in September 2014.

March 2015

Backpack: students can now email their Backpack to parents and teachers by clicking a link at the top-right corner of the backpack landing page

Career Cluster Inventory: the cluster results now link to new Industry Pages; the former printable cluster summaries are now located in the *K-12 Resources* found in Quick Links found at the footer of each page

Career Plan: previously completed Career Cluster Inventory and Budget Calculator activities are now marked as complete in the Career Plan

Guided Tour, First Up: a printable list of Guided Tour activities is now available on the Guided Tour landing page

Job Search: a LinkedIn button has been added for students to see existing connections to a job posting (students need to have an existing LinkedIn account to use this feature); a “report this job” button was added within the search results to report postings that contain errors

Occupation Search: Industry pages have been added to include overviews of industries and related resources; in addition to key word and industry students can now search occupations by education level and salary

Registration: home address is now an optional section for creating an account
