
One Goal



Ohio will increase annually the percentage of its high school graduates who, one year after graduation, are:

- Enrolled and succeeding in a post-high school learning experience, including an adult career-technical education program, an apprenticeship and/or a two-year or four-year college program;
- Serving in a military branch;
- Earning a living wage; or
- Engaged in a meaningful, self-sustaining vocation.


94.61% of #CareerTechOhio students met this goal. After leaving high school in 2018, these students were employed, enlisted, in training, or continuing education within six months.



Of the 94.61% of #CareerTechOhio students:

68.7% were employed	57.2% were enrolled in post-high school learning	4.2% joined the military

DID YOU KNOW? A **concentrator** is a student who has completed a minimum of 50% of the courses required for a single career-technical education workforce development program, and has enrolled for additional credit at the secondary level within the same program. Only one program of concentration can be reported by a district for each student in a year.
