

Industry Credentials and Career-Based Intervention

Q: How can I add industry credentials to CBI so students can earn points toward graduation?

A: Remember that CBI is an intervention, not a pathway. A student can earn credentials in one of the [16 Career Pathways](#). (e.g. Agriculture and Environmental Systems, Arts and Communication, Business Administration, Construction Technologies, etc.)

Q: When will CBI have a credential?

A: It will probably never have a credential because it is not a pathway.

Q: May I offer a certification in my CBI-related class if I have an industry credential available?

A: Yes. If you are following the guidelines for a CBI-related class, you can squeeze in the training for a credential. But you still need to keep in mind that in order to meet the requirements for the industry credential pathway to graduation, a student must earn a total of [12 points](#) in one [Career Pathway](#) (Construction Technologies, Manufacturing, Human Services, etc. etc.).
