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Sponsor Evaluations (ORC 3314.016)

Three Equally-Weighted Components

- ❖ Academic performance
- ❖ Compliance with all laws and rules
- ❖ Adherence to quality practices

Academic Component – Revised Code

3314.016 (B)(1)(a)

*Academic performance of students enrolled in community schools sponsored by the same entity . **The academic performance component shall be derived from the performance measures prescribed for the state report cards under section [3302.03](#) or [3314.017](#) of the Revised Code, and shall be based on the performance of the schools for the school year for which the evaluation is conducted.** In addition to the academic performance for a specific school year, the academic performance component shall also include year-to-year changes in the overall sponsor portfolio. For a community school for which no graded performance measures are applicable or available, the department shall use nonreport card performance measures specified in the contract between the community school and the sponsor under division (A)(4) of section [3314.03](#) of the Revised Code.*

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Academic Component – Operationalized

The 2017 Academic Component will use data from the 2016-2017 report cards

Traditional community schools are graded on up to 6 component grades that are aggregated for each school to produce a total number of weighted points

Schools that serve students in a dropout prevention and recovery program receive an overall rating that is converted to points.

Academic Component – Operationalized

Weighting for traditional community schools depends on the number of components.

Academic Component – Operationalized

Schools that receive a dropout prevention and recovery report card receive an overall rating which translates to points

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Academic Component – Operationalized

Once each school is assigned its number of points, the points are weighted based on the number of students that school represents in proportion to the total number of students in all schools held by that sponsor.

Changes to the sponsor's portfolio also are taken into consideration when calculating the weighted points

Academic Component – Changes to Portfolio

Sponsor had 3 schools on July 1, 2016

School	Overall Academic Performance	Points	Enrollment FTE	Weight	Weighted Points
Community School #1	4	4	250	$X(250/1000)$	1.0
Community School #2	1	1	500	$X(500/1000)$	0.5
Dropout Recovery School # 3	Meets	2	250	$X(250/1000)$	0.5
Total Weighted Points					2.0

Academic Component – Changes to Portfolio

Sponsor had 2 schools on July 1, 2017

School	Overall Academic Performance	Points	Enrollment FTE	Weight	Weighted Points
Community School #1	4	4	250	X(250/500)	2.0
Dropout Recovery School # 3	Meets	2	250	X(250/500)	1.0
Total Weighted Points					3.0

Academic Component – Changes to Portfolio

The results of the two portfolios are then averaged, resulting in a score of:

$$(2.0 + 3.0)/2 = 2.5$$

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
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Academic Component – Schools with No Grades

When no graded performance measures are applicable, HB 2 requires the department to use measures specified in the contract between the sponsor and the community school.

For those schools, the contracts between the schools and sponsors will be reviewed by the Ohio Department of Education's Office of Accountability with the assistance from the Office of Community Schools and the Office of Legal Counsel.

Academic Component – Final Rating

Once the final number of points is calculated based on the changes to each sponsor's portfolio, the points are converted to a 0 to 4 whole number scale using the table below.

Academic Component – Operationalized

Weighted Points	Grade (or Equivalent)	Points Earned for Academic Performance Component
3.5 – 4	A	4
2.5 – 3.49	B	3
1.5 – 2.49	C	2
.5 – 1.49	D	1
0 – .49	F	0
