Ohio students have made steady, long-term academic gains, thanks to higher expectations, dedicated educators, and students who understand how

increased learning relates to their life plans. The results on the 2010-2011 State Report Card demonstrate these improvements.

Ohio can take great pride in this year's statewide results. The percentage of students scoring proficient or above on state tests increased on 21 of the 26 indicators, with the strongest gains in third-grade math, eighth-grade math and 10th-grade writing. Overall, students met the state's performance goal on 17 out of the 26 indicators, one less than last year. The Performance Index, the statewide measure of all students' test scores, jumped 1.7 points to 95, the biggest gain since the 2004-2005 school year.

This year, 352 districts ranked Excellent with Distinction or Excellent, an increase of 56 over last year. The number of schools in those same categories grew by 186 to 1,769.

While we celebrate this progress, our education system and our state will need to make even greater strides to realize a future in which all students graduate from high school fully prepared for further learning or a career. We must reduce the number of students who never earn a diploma, or who need remedial work in college or job preparation training. And we must narrow the significant achievement gaps that remain in the performance levels among student groups.

Ohio is in the midst of tremendous educational change. We were selected by the U.S. Department of Education as a winner of \$400 million in Race to the Top funds. As a result, Ohio will introduce world class learning standards for all students, promote great teachers and school leaders to help students master those standards, develop new data systems to support instruction, and focus on turning around the lowest-achieving schools.

Hundreds of school districts around Ohio are hard at work turning this vision into reality. These students, parents, school leaders and community supporters across Ohio are to be honored for engaging in this challenging work that will truly improve how students learn and prepare for the future.

The Ohio Department of Education remains dedicated to supporting the students, parents, teachers and school leaders who are helping build a better future for our children and our state.

The six designations are Excellent with Distinction, Excellent, Effective, Continuous Improvement, Academic Watch and Academic Emergency.



The National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), often referred to as "The Nation's Report Card," is the only nationally representative and continuing assessment that enables the comparision of performance in Ohio and other states in various subject areas. Schools and students within each state are selected randomly to be a part of the assessment. Not all students in the state or in a particular school take the assessment. Data are reported at the state level only, and there are no individual student or even school summary results.

The assessments are conducted in mathematics, reading, science, writing, the arts, civics, economics, geography and U.S. history.
