Background of the Council and Workgroups





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EMIS Advisory Council, 1

- Authorized by Ohio Revised Code §3301.0713
- Purpose of the Council is to make recommendations to improve EMIS and to provide a forum for communication and collaboration between the Department and parties in the field involved in collecting, reporting, and using EMIS data.
- Goal of the Council is to analyze all aspects of the EMIS system and gather both short- and long-term recommendations to present to the State Superintendent



EMIS Advisory Council, 2

- First established in Sept. 2018
- Currently consists of 24 members
- Members are nominated by various stakeholder groups

 Includes two State Board of Education members
- Over the last four years, the Council has convened 14 times and <u>published four annual reports</u>.



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Workgroups, 1

- The Council has established smaller workgroups to address both strengths and challenges associated with different components of EMIS.
- Workgroups make a set of formal recommendations for improvements to EMIS that are reviewed and approved by the Council





Workgroups, 2

- Ten workgroups established since the Council first began.
 - -Nine completed workgroups
 - -Two ongoing (including this Special Ed workgroup)
- The Council identified Special Education EMIS data reporting as a future workgroup need in their Oct 20 meeting

- Examining interactions between special education reporting and EMIS. Including, but not limited to the following.
 - –Data reported to the Department
 - Challenges in data reporting, streamlining data, unmet data needs, etc.
 - -Staff roles and collaboration within districts
 - –Intersection of policy and data
 - -Resources and reports made available by the Department to aid districts in reporting and analyzing data, tracking accountability, and analyzing student services.
