

#### Data Source

These data come from the *STUDENT\_FTE*, *SPECED\_EVENT*, and *OEDS* files. The first file is submitted by the districts as the *Standing (FS)*, *Student Attributes* – *Effective Date Record (FS)* and *Student Demographic (GI)* records and aggregated into the *STUDENT\_FTE* records. These data must be sorted by district then building IRN.

#### **Derived Data Used in Report**

#### **Report Selection Criteria**

The program will select all disabled students from city, local, exempted village school districts, community schools, and STEM districts.

Filters include students reported with a disability code only,

and

the disabled student has a percent of time greater than zero **OR** the reporting district = the legal district of residence.

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The program excludes:

- Contract career technical students with Attending/Home Status = 12
- Resident district students who are enrolled at ODYS with Attending/Home Status = 28
- In state student attending a non-public school with Attending/Home Status = 16

#### Logic

When a student with a disability is reported, the program will check the special ed record to see if a record was reported by the reporting district for the SSID for the current fiscal year and reporting period. If a record does not exist, the SSID will be added to the report for the district.
