Who Takes EOC Exams

- ▶ Students who were first time ninth graders **on or after** July 1, 2014, will take EOC exams
- ▶ Students below grade 9 taking high school courses for high school credit will take the EOC exams for those courses
- ▶ Students who were first time ninth graders **before** July 1, 2014, will take the OGT
 - ▶ Retained ninth grade students
 - ▶ Students who have to retake sections of the OGT

Who Takes EOC Exams, cont.

American History and American Government

- ▶ All high school students enrolled in these courses as year long or second semester courses will take the EOC exam
- ▶ This includes those students who will be taking the OGT
- ▶ *Exception:* Students taking the Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate American History or American Government tests do not have to take the EOC exam

Missing Report

- ▶ Fiscal Year that Student Began Ninth Grade Element used to determine who is tested
- ▶ Listed courses: All students enrolled during the assessment window who do not have a test record will appear on the missing report
- ▶ Unlisted courses: If a TBD percentage of students in the course have an assessment record, then any enrolled in the course during the assessment window who do not have a test record will appear on the missing report
- ▶ SSIDs in the vendor file without a corresponding Student Assessment (FA) Record will appear on the missing report

New Score Not Reported Reasons

- ▶ G – EOC assessment (GE) not given for the course in which the student is enrolled within this district.
- ▶ H – SSID for this student appears on the assessment vendor file due to a data error; student with this SSID was not required to be assessed.
- ▶ W – Assessment score not reported because student received graduation credit for assessment area due to course completion prior to end of course assessment availability. Number in score field represents number of graduation points earned.

New Reasons, cont.

- ▶ X – Assessment score not reported because student received graduation credit for assessment area due to completion of a dual credit course. Number in score field represents number of graduation points earned.
- ▶ Y – Student transferred in with course already completed; number of required graduation points reduced.

- ▶ Select date by fiscal year student was last enrolled (or select “All”)

Preview Reports in Current Collections

Verify data continuously; don't wait for Level 2s and post processing reports

- L – years of experience, salary, HQT, position codes, course information, CTE, etc.
- S – attendance, disability condition, Sp Ed events, grad records, etc.
- C – calendar hours, calendar type, DN exceptions, etc.
- SCR – submit regularly, all students, new students, fatal errors, etc.
