### **Severity Codes**

- ► Each row on the report will be assigned a Severity Code
- Severity codes display in the (CTEA-000) CTE FTE Detail Report as follows
  - > ADJSTD FTE = 0
    - Severity Code is Fatal
  - > ADJSTD FTE < ORIG FTE and ADJSTD\_FTE
    is not 0</pre>
    - Severity Code is Critical
  - ADJSTD FTE = ORIG FTE
    - Severity Code is Informational

#### **Result Codes**

Result	
Code	Result Code Description
CS0008	Academic courses with curriculum code VA or VB not valid for funding
CS0016	Correlated class missing for V3 course
CS0020	WFD course not approved by the Office of CTE

### **Adjustments**

- Once base CTE FTE is determined for row of data
  - Adjustments due to student, course, or staff errors may need to be applied
- ▶ Example
  - CS0020 Workforce Development Course not approved by the Office of CTE for Location IRN on course
    - Contact Office of Career Tech for research

#### **Other Reports**

- If a "Y" in an error flag column, then will appear on corresponding adjustment report
  - Student Level Error Flag (SC)
  - Course Level Error Flag (CS)
  - Staff Level Error Flag (SF)
- Districts will only see students they are educating on adjustment reports

### (CTEA-001) CTE Student Error Detail Report

- ▶ Result Codes begin with SC
- ► Student Level Error Flag = Y
- ▶ Example
  - SC0015 Student's total adjusted CTE FTE greater than student's total regular base FTE multiplied by 1.1
    - CTE FTE proportionally reduced across all courses

### (CTEA-001) CTE Student Error Detail Report, cont.

- ▶ Result Code SC0005 Subject code not valid for curriculum code is a duplicate code that has been disabled
- Result Codes reducing FTE proportionally
  - SC0014 Student's course-level CTE FTE is greater than student's regular FTE
  - SC0015 Student's total CTE FTE is greater than student's regular FTE

### (CTEA-002) CTE Course Error Detail Report

- ▶ Result Codes begin with CS
- ► Course Level Error Flag = Y
- ▶ Example
  - CS0003 –V3 course not correlated to anchor course
    - Curriculum code for anchor course must be VN, VC, VT, or VP

### (CTEA-002) CTE Course Error Detail Report, cont.

- ▶ Result Code CS0012 Semester code not valid for career tech is a duplicate code that has been disabled
- ▶ Result Code CS0007 Instructional hours greater than maximum hours required per CTE Matrix reduces FTE proportionally

### (CTEA-003) CTE Staff Error Detail Report

- ▶ Result Codes begin with SF
- ► Staff Level Error Flag = Y
- ▶ Example
  - SF0002 Teacher does not have appropriate certificate/license to teach course
    - Contact Office of Career Tech to request override

### (CTEA-003) CTE Staff Error Detail Report, cont.

- ▶ Result Code SF0003 Teacher does not meet appointment or status requirements is not in production yet
- ▶ Result Code SF0004 Total CTE length of scheduled instruction greater than 1080 hours reduces FTE proportionally

### **New CTE Reports**

- Several new reports coming
- ▶ Assist with variety of CTE data
  - Concentrators
  - Participants
  - Assessments
  - > Enrollment
  - CTE Report Card measures

### **CTE Override Report**

- Applied and released by late March/early April
- If override approved
  - Row/data will still appear on (CTEA-000)
    CTE FTE Detail Report
    - → ERR OVERID FLAG set to Y
  - Row appears on the new Override report
  - No longer appears on error reports

### **CTE FTE Rollup/Summary**

- ▶ Alert districts to drastic changes in data
- Assist districts in reconciling data by submission with payment report
- ▶ Will include FTE for following timeframes
  - A separate FTE for each of the previous 5 days
  - FTEs for 1 week ago and 2 weeks ago
  - FTEs for 1 month ago and 2 months ago
  - > FTE average for previous 30 days

#### **Participants and Concentrators**

- ▶ Two separate reports
- ▶ Participants impacts the FY18 and FY19 CTE Report Cards
  - All students enrolled in a WFD program course will appear on report
  - High School Credit Earned (GN150)
  - > Partial/Override Credit (GN152)
- ▶ Concentrators
  - Verify data while students still in school
  - > Will help avoid March Follow-up issues

### **Additional Reports**

- Assessments
  - Course level as well as pathway level
  - CTE technical assessment (GY) data
  - Will include missing list, populated from course data and vendor data
- Academic Indicators on CTE Report Card
  - Current year participants
  - End of course exams
- ► CTPD Enrollment
  - > TBD

### (CTFL-002) CTE March Follow-up Extract for FFE

- ▶ Download from Data Collector
- Change to .SEQ and import into Flat File Editor
- ▶ Update with survey results
- Export from FFE and upload to Data Sources/Other Files area in Data Collector
  - Automatically exports in .SEQ format
  - Can be changed to .TXT

### **Missing List**

- Generated based on students in original ODE file
  - Not included in upload
  - > Excluded due to fatal Level 1 error
- Placeholder record added to Preview and Submission files
  - Default values for each element
- ▶ Other Follow-up Status (GV660)
  - X = Incorrectly reported by district as a CTE Concentrator

### (CTFL-003) CTE March Follow Up Extract for FFE – Approved Appeals

- Additional students based on approved appeal
  - Affected districts will receive notification of report availability for added students
- ▶ Follow same procedure for updating as with CTE March Follow-up Extract for FFE

# Full Academic Year (FAY)

- Continuously enrolled in a building/district from Friday of first full week of October through spring testing
  - Based on grade level
- ►ODE uses the Majority of Attendance IRN (FN220) to determine if student met full academic year criteria for inclusion in report card measures

# **Majority of Attendance IRN**

- ▶ Reportable in
  - > Traditional District Midyear and End of Year Student (S) Collections
  - SOES End of Year Student (S) Collection
- ▶ Valid options
  - > \*\*\*\*\* FAY not met
  - Building IRN FAY met at building
  - District IRN − FAY met at district

# Majority of Attendance IRN, cont.

Reported by resident/sending district as though student enrolled/attending their building

- College Credit Plus, Sent Reason = PS
- Attending a Board of DD, Sent Reason = MR
- Attending a JVSD, Sent Reason = JV
- Contract Career-Tech, Sent Reason = CT
- > ESC school-age students, regular student reporting
