

# Updated EMIS Data Collection Calendar

- Adjustments reflect changes due to ordered building closure and HB 197
- Multiple collections extended
  - Value-added data calculation requirement eliminated
- Spring assessment collections cancelled
  - Spring assessments will not be administered

# Assessment Collections

- Spring 3-8, EOC, and Alternate Assessment collections have been inactivated
- Missing lists will be based only on vendor file for all other collections
  - No enrollment-based students will appear

# Data Appeals

- Revised EMIS data appeal dates
- Three appeal windows opening later April
  - Including new one for Fall End of Course State Assessment data
- Appeal windows for many collections closing in August, extended by several days

# Calendar and Attendance

# Minimum Instructional Hours

- Requirements unchanged
- Districts should ***not*** consider shortening school year or ending early
- HB 197 allows flexibility for how to deliver instruction

# Organization – General Information (DN) Record

- Effective March 1 on, use calamity day attribute for days closed due to statewide closure
  - Originally scheduled to be in session
- Calamity day ***and*** blizzard bag attributes for days when instruction provided
  - Number of hours as reported on calendar prior to building closure for blizzard bag attribute

# COVID-19 and Student Attendance

- Students should generally be considered in attendance during the closure
  - Report as present
- HB 197 did not waive the absence and truancy requirements of HB 410, but does recognize the need for flexibility
  - Does not apply to E-schools and community schools operating blended models

# Where Kids Count (WKC)

# Full Academic Year (FAY)

- Friday of first full week of October through spring testing
- A student who was continuously enrolled during this timeframe has met FAY
  - Building or district level
- Reported as Majority of Attendance IRN (FN220)

- Performance Index
- *Improving At-Risk K-3 Readers*
- Five value-added calculations
  - “All Students”, Gifted, IEP, Lowest 20%, and High Mobility

# Majority of Attendance IRN

- Reported by traditional districts, community schools, STEM districts, and ESCs
- Valid options
  - \*\*\*\*\* – FAY not met
  - Building IRN – FAY met at building
  - District IRN – FAY met at district

# MOA IRN Exceptions

Resident/sending districts report as though student enrolled/attending their building

- College Credit Plus, Sent Reason PS
- Attending a Board of DD, Sent Reason MR
- Attending a JVSD, Sent Reason JV
- Contract Career-Tech, Sent Reason CT
- Non-public at district expense, Sent Reason NP
- Attending a state school, Sent Reason OS
- ESC school-age students, regular student reporting

# WKC Methodology

- ODE applies business rules to determine
  - Which students included in each calculation and total *and*
  - If students count at building, district or state level
- Business rules based on data effective on March 31

- Additional filters applied at ODE not reflected

- Report card ratings and overall grades will not be assigned for FY20
- Provides schools and districts with access to Local Report Card data and other reports
  - Populated by ODE with district data as submitted to EMIS twice weekly
- Reports used to ensure data quality and preview report card results
- Open status announced via Twitter
  - Exceptions via EMIS Newsflash


