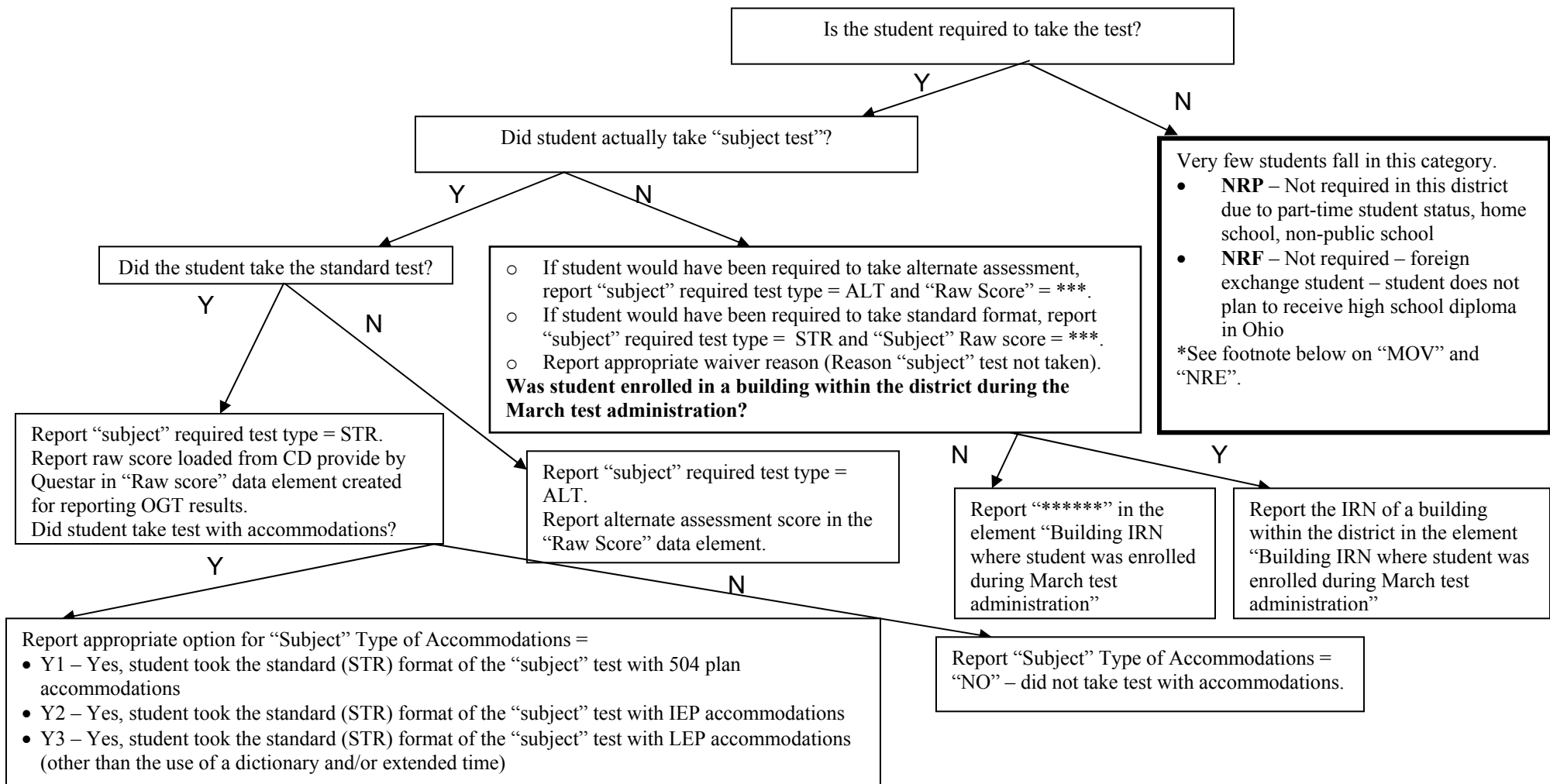


## DRAFT: Decision Tree for FY2004 EMIS Reporting: OGT Reading and Math Tests



- Report "subject" "MOV" if student moves out of district prior to the test report and is not enrolled for any administration during the current school year.
- Report "NRE" if student was not enrolled in any Ohio public school district during test administration during the current school year (but enrolls AFTER the administrations), report NRE - Not required to take subject /grade level test.
- NRL option will be added when there is a citizenship test for OGT
- **NRL** – Not required – foreign exchange student – Citizenship test only – student plans to leave country (United States) after graduation
- NRS would be reported for the Writing, Citizenship and Science test for the OGT.
- There is ONLY a standards-based alternate assessment for the reading and Math OGT. Therefore, appropriate results will be reported in the "Subject" Alternate Assessment Results element. (If student did not take test, report \*\*\*. DO NOT report "AAA, BBB, CCC, or DDD" for the reading and Math OGT. This will result in a fatal error.)
- Because the OGT is not a graduation requirement for tenth grade students taking the reading and math OGT in 2003-2004 who plan to graduate before the class of 2007, the "Subject" test required for Graduation element should always = "\*\*\*" – not applicable.
