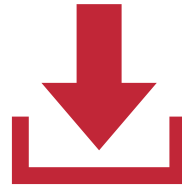

Achievement

The Achievement component measures the skills and knowledge learned in student's career-technical programs using aligned technical assessments and academic achievement using each level of performance on Ohio's State Tests.

Technical Skill Attainment

Technical Skill Attainment measures the proportion of students passing technical assessments. These assessments are designed to measure the skills and knowledge learned in a student's career-technical program.

Performance Index

The Performance Index measures the test results of every student, not just those who score proficient or higher. This includes results in English language arts, mathematics, science and social studies. There are seven levels on the index and CTPDs receive points for every CTE concentrator who takes a test. The higher the achievement level, the more points awarded in the CTPD's index. This rewards CTPDs for improving the performance of all students, regardless of achievement level.

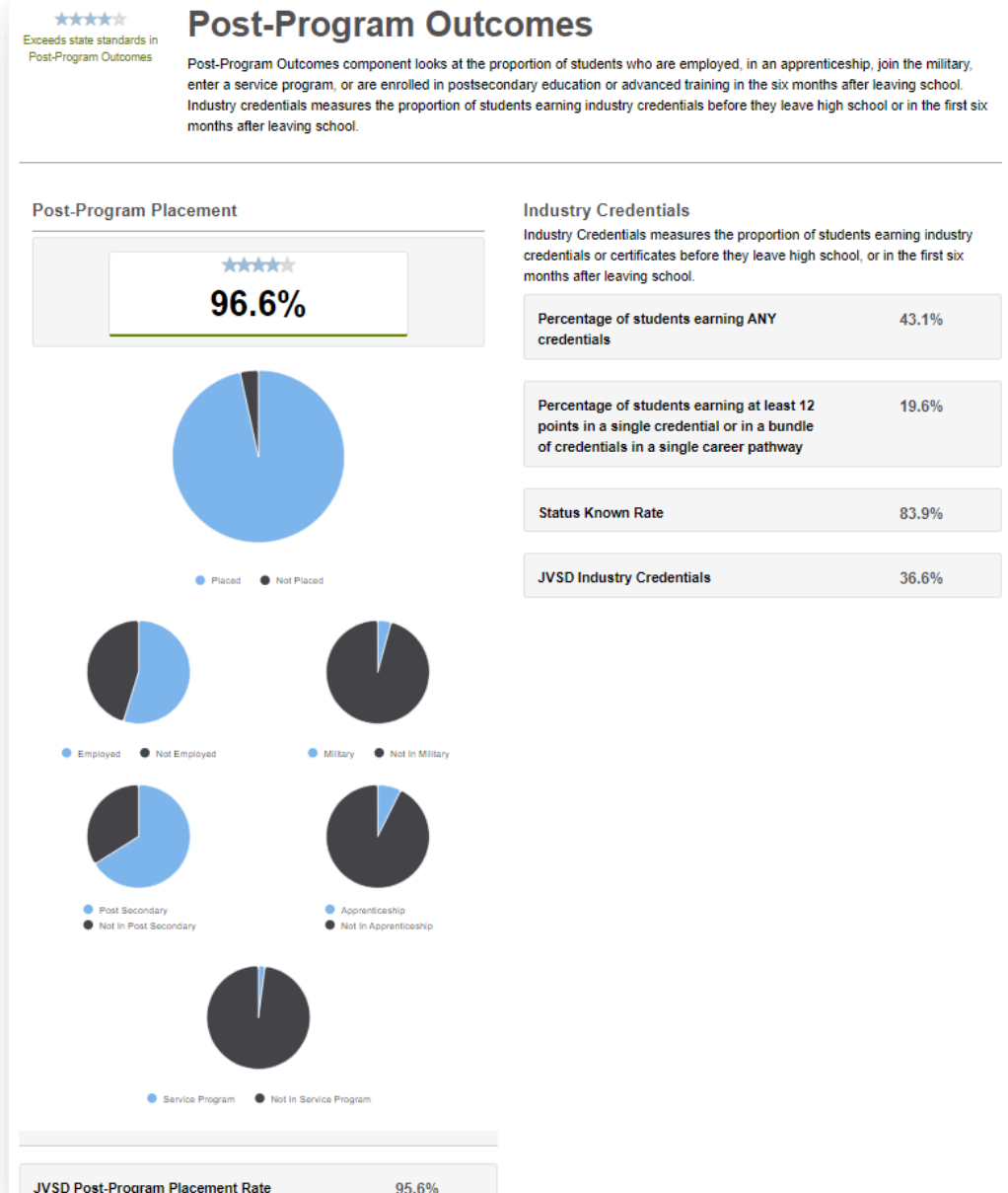

Report Cards are designed to give parents, communities, educators and policymakers information about the performance of districts and schools — to celebrate achievement and success and identify areas for improvement. The information provides clear and easily available reporting on student performance, drives local conversations on school improvement and identifies schools to receive supports for getting better. The goal is to ensure all students receive an excellent education that can lead to success in life, careers and future learning.

Report cards are only one part of the story about what is happening in schools and districts. 

TO VIEW REPORT INFORMATION

Click the *Report information* icon (a lowercase "i") on the right edge of the screen. A pop-up window will display information about the current report if available. Some reports may not have additional information.

TO VIEW IN FULL SCREEN MODE

Click the *Enter full screen mode* icon (brackets at the corners of a square) on the right edge of the screen. The report will enter full screen mode.

To exit full screen mode, follow your web browser's on-screen instructions. Each browser does this differently, but some examples are to press the Escape key or click/tap a "close" or "X" button.

TO PRINT A REPORT

Printing is accomplished by converting a report to a printable PDF. Adobe Acrobat Reader or a browser capable of reading PDFs is required. Only one tab of a report can be printed or downloaded at a time.

Click the *Print* icon on the right edge of the screen. A pop-up window specific to your browser will appear to begin the printing process. On a Windows PC, the pop-up allows you to select which pages of the report to print, whether to use portrait or landscape mode, and whether to send the report directly to the printer or save the PDF to your computer.

TO EXPORT DATA

Click the *Export data* icon (an arrow pointing down to a computer) on the right edge of the screen. A pop-up window will list the sections on the current page of the report. Select the section(s) containing the data you wish to export. The data will be exported to a comma-separated values (.csv) file and downloaded to your computer. A .csv file can be opened by a spreadsheet program such as Microsoft Excel or Google Sheets.

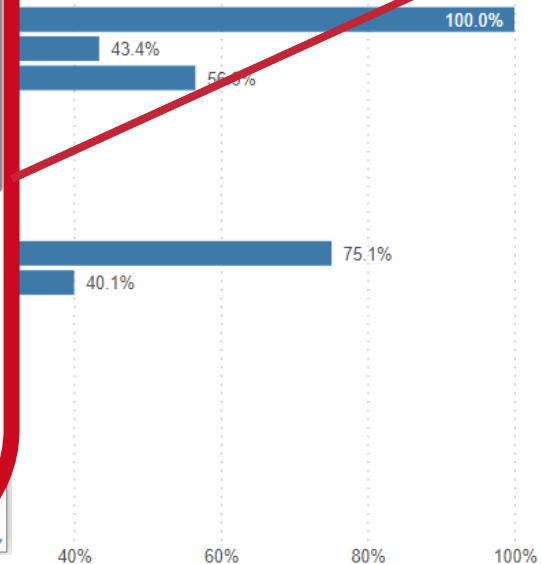
If a report section has more than 30,000 rows (uncommon), you must use a different method. Hover your mouse over the report section until you see a small menu of icons appear at the top right of the section. One of the icons is *More options* (three periods). Click this icon, then select *Export data*. Follow the on-screen instructions to export the data to an .xlsx (Microsoft Excel) file, which has a limit of 150,000 rows.

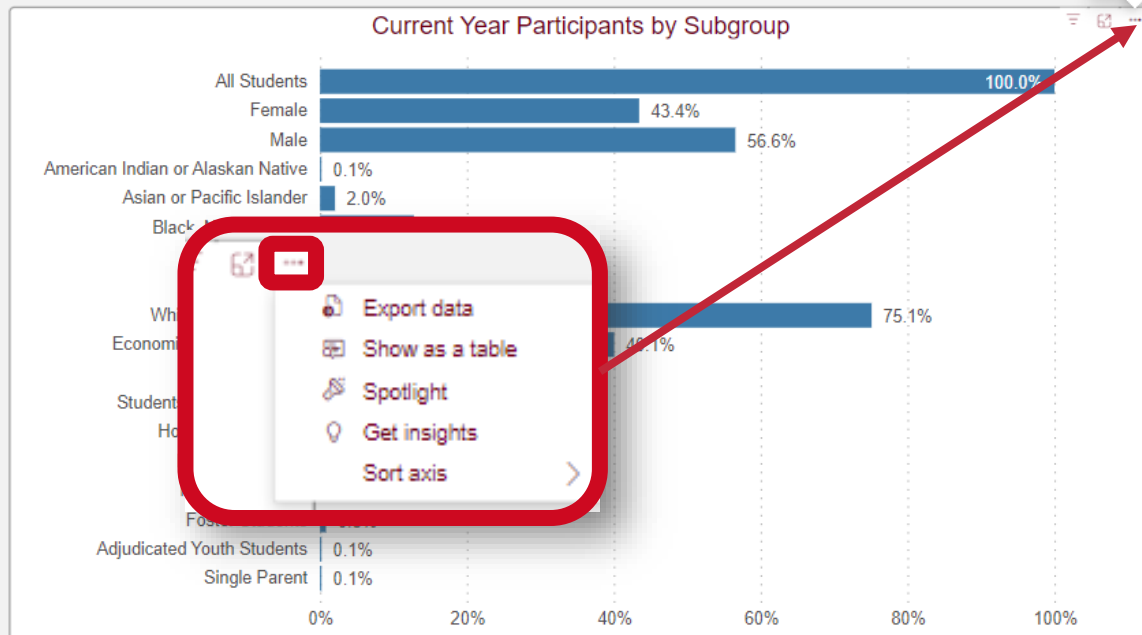

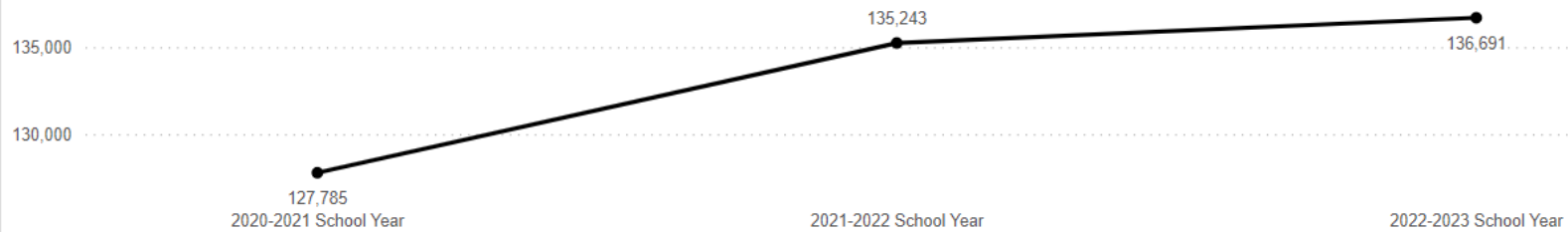

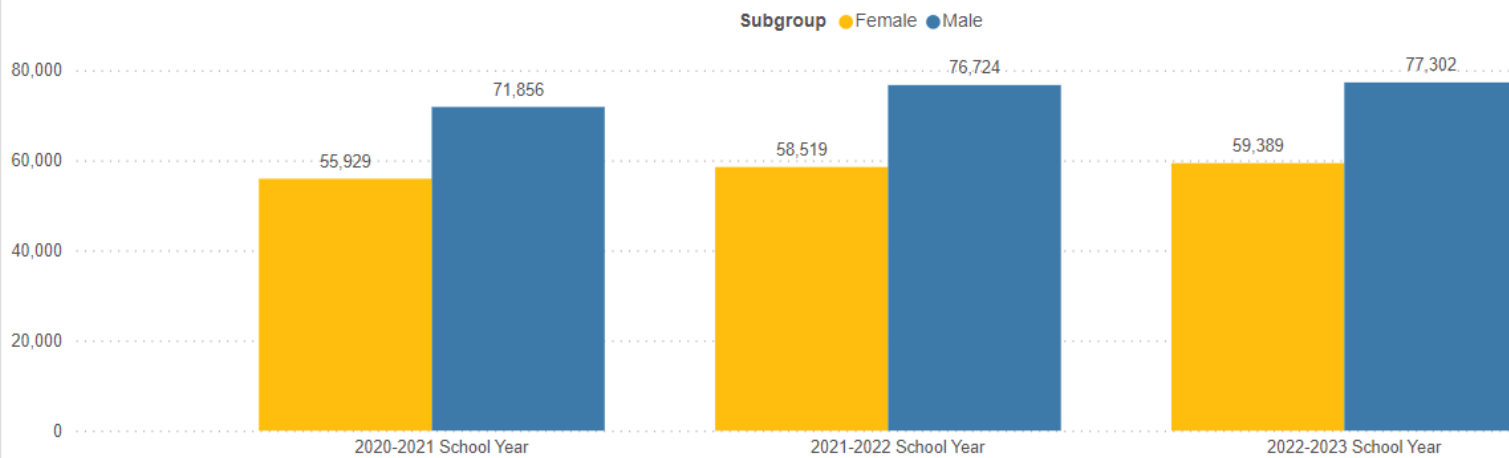

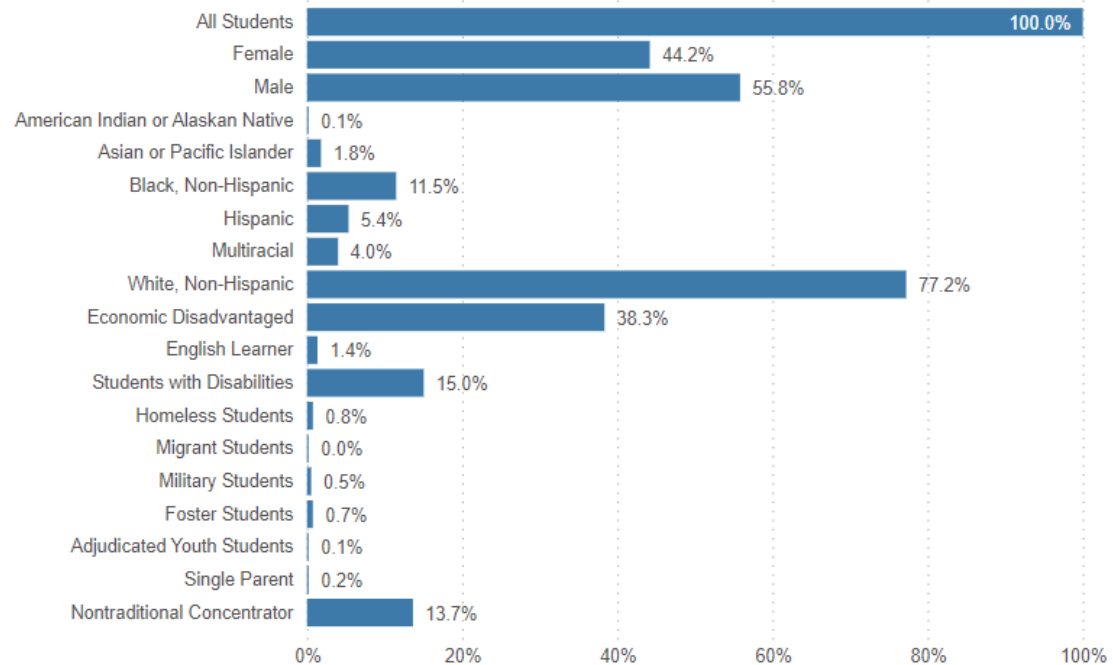
