The Ohio General Assembly amended Ohio's accountability law in the summer of 2021. Schools and districts now receive an overall rating and star ratings for five components. The information provides clear and easily available reporting on student performance, drives local conversations on school improvement and identifies schools to receive supports for getting better. The goal is to ensure all students receive an excellent education that can lead to success in life, careers and future learning.

Report cards are only one part of the story about what is happening in schools and districts. 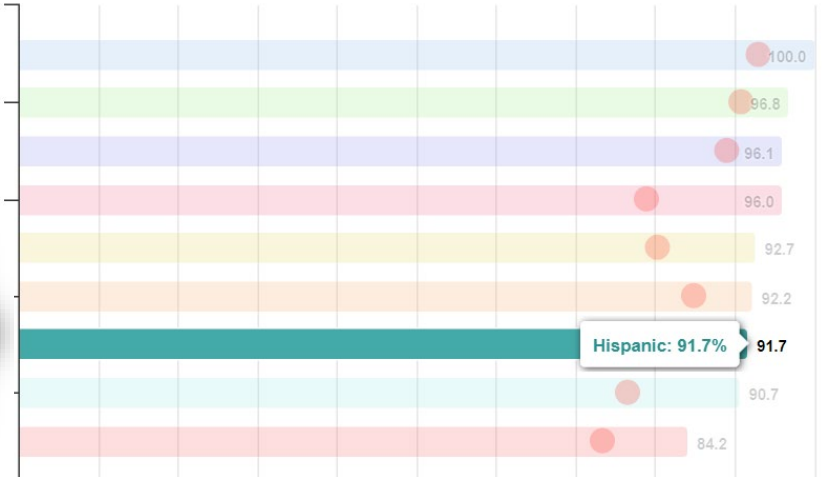
