New Report: Student Success Summary

With the release of the 2018-19 reporting, SAS EVAAS and the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) are offering a new report called the Student Success Summary. The Student Success Summary, which was piloted by some districts last year, provides district and school personnel with important information about their students' past performance on state tests and likely performance on future tests. This information should help teachers and other educational personnel engage in collaborative planning to meet their students' needs.

Additional Data Included in the Accountability Value-Added Report

Based on feedback from the field, EVAAS will now provide up-to-two year measures within the Accountability Value-Added report starting in 2019.

Changes to Projection Summaries and College Readiness Dashboard

Projections historically reported through the College Readiness Dashboard are now reported through the Projection Summary Report. The Projection Summary report contains the same information for these projections that users previously accessed through the College Readiness Dashboard.

Removal of Selected Reporting and Projections

Beginning in 2019, EVAAS no longer provides vendor-based or OST grade 3 reporting as the vendor-based assessments are no longer administered. As a result, EVAAS is:

- Removing vendor-based value-added measures.
- No longer providing projections to OST grades 3 and 4 assessments.
- Removing OST grade 3 Math and ELA value-added measures.
- Removing OST grade 4 Social Studies value-added measures.
