






Early Childhood IDEA Funds




- Category 1 \$1,578


Category 5 \$17,390

State Funding Example

\$4,000 *20 (category count of students)
+
.5 * \$1,578 (category 1 amount)
* .45 (the state share for the district)
* 20 (category count of students)
= \$87,101.00


