and Permissions**

Chartered nonpublic school are now exempt from the requirement that high schools comply with a State Board of Education credit flexibility plan.	3313.603	Starting September 29, 2011
Provisions restricting the calorie and fat levels of milk sold a la carte in chartered and nonpublic schools is repealed.	3313.816	Starting September 29, 2011
Sponsors of "brick and mortar" community schools no longer have to be located or have representatives located within 50 miles of the location of the community school. Sponsors of e-schools no longer have to be located within 50 miles of the school's base of operation.	3314.023	Starting September 29, 2011
The requirement that e-schools spend at least as much as the per pupil statewide classroom teacher amount specified under the former "Building Blocks" school funding model has been eliminated.	3314.085	Starting July 1, 2011
Local school districts no longer must file their membership records with the ESC at the close of each school year.	3317.031	Starting July 1, 2011
School districts and ESCs are no longer required to file a copy of its teacher salary schedule with the State Superintendent.	3317.14	Starting September 29, 2011
Local boards of education no longer have to provide 15 days of sick leave with pay per year to the following: substitutes, adult education instructors who work the full-time equivalent of less than 120 days per school year, and persons employed on an as-needed, seasonal, or intermittent basis.	3319.141	Starting September 29, 2011
Local school districts no longer must adopt their textbooks or electronic textbooks from lists provided by ESCs.	3329.08	Starting September 29, 2011
Permissive language is removed that allowed an ESC superintendent to be the designee of a "local" school district's superintendent within the ESC's service territory in issuing age and school certificates	3331.01	Starting September 29, 2011
