

The public view of the Comprehensive Continuous Improvement Plan (CCIP) system provides public stakeholders an opportunity to view information for any grantee. This document describes the process for viewing an application and plan (if applicable).

Accessing an Application

1. Access the Comprehensive Continuous Improvement Plan (CCIP) at <https://ccip.ode.state.oh.us>.
2. Use the menu on the left-hand side to hover over **search** and then select **organization**.



Type in the name of the organization of interest and click the **Search** button.



4. Hover over **funding** and click **Funding Applications** to access a list of all funding applications.



- Review the year to ensure the appropriate one is selected. If a different year is needed, use the drop-down menu to select the appropriate year. For Application status, selecting “All Approved Applications” displays the original application (Rev 0) and any subsequent revisions to that application (Rev 1, Rev 2, etc.), if applicable. Selecting “All Approved Applications” will display only the most recent revision for the application.

Once the appropriate year and application status is displayed, select the funding application you wish to view (for example, “Consolidated, Rev 0”).


