FY15 Final #4

The FY15 Final #4 adjustment will occur with the FY17 August payment. This will be the final reconciliation for FY15 data.

Community School Payment Report and Data

The June payment report is a comprehensive tool designed to walk the user through every step of the funding formula and shows the payment calculations. This report is commonly known as the School Finance Payment Report (SFPR).

- Updated FY16 enrollment data provided in June 2016 through the EMIS data collector and SOES are used for the following funding categories:
 - Opportunity Grant
 - Targeted Assistance
 - Special Education
 - Limited English Proficiency
 - o Economically Disadvantaged
 - o K-3 Literacy
- Career tech funding is based on the CTA course data entered in the FY2016 EMIS records and the matching FY2016 career tech data entered in the SOES system.
- The targeted assistance per-pupil amount and economically disadvantaged index both utilize the resident district's most recent FY16 data.
- Transportation payments are based on actual data submitted through SOES in FY16 for community schools that provide direct transportation to their students.
