This is the fourth payment of FY2019 and uses formula and factors based on the implemented provisions of **Am. Sub. H.B. 49** (the FY2018-2019 budget bill). The October payment is based partially on **FY2019** EMIS data elements as of September 22, 2018.

The sections below contain additional information on the FY2019 October and future payments.

## **FY2019 Payment Dates**

Payments to community schools are made no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> business day of each month. The scheduled payment dates for FY2019 are as follows:

July 13, 2018 August 14, 2018 September 14, 2018 October 12, 2018 November 14, 2018 December 14, 2018 January 14, 2019 February 14, 2019 March 14, 2019 April 12, 2019 May 14, 2019 June 14, 2019

## **Community School Payment Report and Data**

The October payment report is a comprehensive tool designed to walk the user through every step of the funding formula and shows the payment calculations. This report is commonly known as the School Finance Payment Report (SFPR).

- Updated **FY2019** enrollment data provided as of September 25, 2018 through the EMIS data collector and SOES are used for the following funding categories:
  - Opportunity Grant
  - o Targeted Assistance
  - o Special Education
  - o Limited English Proficiency
  - o Economically Disadvantaged
  - o K-3 Literacy

- Career tech funding is based on the CTA course data entered in the FY2018 EMIS records and the matching FY2018 career tech data entered in the SOES system.
- The targeted assistance per-pupil amount and economically disadvantaged index reflects the resident district's most recent FY2018 data.
- Transportation payments are paid based on actual ridership data submitted through EMIS in FY2018 for community schools that provide direct transportation to their students.
- FY17 Final #1 deductions that were spread over the course of one or more fiscal years (for some schools) will continue to impact settlement reports.
- FY18 Final #1 deductions that were spread over the course of one or more fiscal years (for some schools) will impact settlement reports.
