Fiscal Year 2024 November Community/STEM School Payment on November 14, 2023

General Information on State Foundation Payments

Foundation payments to community/STEM schools are calculated once a month. This letter, generated with each foundation payment, provides details about updated payments to these entities including deductions, adjustments and transfers. The scheduled payment dates for FY 2024 are below:

July 14, 2023	January 12, 2024

The recently enacted state budget (Amended Substitute House Bill 33 of the 135th General Assembly) included several changes to the calculation of state foundation funding. The provisions of the budget have been fully implemented.

Information Relevant to the November Payment

- **FY 2024** ADM and categorical data for special education, English Learners and economically disadvantaged students are based on compilations as of 11/1/23.
- **FY 2023** Final #2 adjustments were included in the November payment. Adjustments were made using JV34. Adjustment amounts can be viewed at the following [link](#).
- Dropout recovery E-schools that participated in the H.B. 123 pilot funding for FY 2023 will be receiving their fifth and final payment in November.
- Feminine hygiene dispenser payments were included in the November payment. Payments were made using JV20.
- Regular Transportation funding calculation is based on **FY 2023** statewide average per rider amount applied to FY 2023 T-1 mileage and ridership data as of 9/29/23 and distributed based on 100% of the calculated amount.
- FY17 Final #1, FY19 Final #1, FY20 Final #1 deductions that were spread over the course of one or more fiscal years (for some schools) will continue to impact settlement reports.
- School facilities funding is calculated at \$1,000 per FTE for each brick and mortar community school, and \$25 per FTE for each e-school. The overall cap on facilities funding for community schools has been increased to \$87,055,000 for FY24. The amount of FTE's in the calculation has exceeded the funding cap for facilities. As a result, the facilities payment was prorated to 97.3863247%.

Known Issues and Updates in This Payment

- The equity supplement payment that has been calculated for brick and mortar schools was inadvertently applied to independent STEM schools as well in October. H.B. 33, Sec. 265.285

does not include STEM schools in this payment. The Equity Supplement was corrected and removed from STEM schools in the November payment.

Statement of Settlement

The Statement of Settlement shows the amount of funding by component paid monthly from SFPR and non-SFPR sources. Typically, the monthly amounts fluctuate based on data updates that occur during each payment period. On the statement of settlement, funds are generally paid out on a [percentage basis or the remaining payments of the year basis](#).
