

Updated FY15 Community School Flag Appeal Timeline

Introduction

The deadline for schools to revise FY15 data has been extended to January 8th to provide schools with more time to review reports and records. As a result, the timeline for updating and appealing FY15 flags has also been extended. The table below shows the new timeline:

Issues	Deadlines
Last day for District of Residence (DOR) to place flags on updated FY15 data	Wednesday, January 13
Last day for DOR to remove flags	Tuesday, January 19
Last day for Community Schools/Resident Districts to appeal flags to Area Coordinators	Wednesday, January 20
Last day for Area Coordinators to send flag removal requests to ODE	Friday, January 22

Focus on Fatal Flags

Districts of Residence, Community Schools, and Area Coordinators should only focus on resolving fatal flags for FY15 data. These flags impact funding and are the top priority.

Below is a list of the FY15 fatal flags with descriptions:

Address Not in Territory – Code 10

This flag should be selected only if a resident district has valid proof the address provided does not fall within the territory boundaries of the district.

Graduated – Code 80

This flag should be selected if the resident district believes that a student has already graduated from high school.

Incorrect District – Code D0

The student is in a guardianship situation, and this district is not the correct district where the parent resides or resided per RC 3313.64 (C) or RC 3323.01(M) or in accordance with a court order concerning responsibility for educational costs.

Homeless Challenge – Code F0

This flag should be selected if the district of origin assigned to a homeless student is challenged.
