## **Community School Payment Report**

- Career tech weighted funding is based on the CTA course data entered in the FY2011
   October EMIS records and the matching FY2011 career tech data entered in the SOES system.
- Students enrolled in an e-school who did not take one of the required state achievement tests for two consecutive years were not funded.
- Special education weighted funding is provided for students 1) with an IEP completed on or before December 1, 2011 and are no more than 12 months old at December 1, and 2) assigned both an appropriate disability condition and Outcome ID in SOES.
- Students with an enrollment date that overlaps with another community school or an EdChoice scholarship are not funded.
- FY2011 EMAD OWF numbers are applied. Academic intervention funds transferred to the community school are based on the number of OWF community school students attending the community school.
