DATE: July 13, 2007

With the start of a new biennium, this payment reflects the factors based on Am. Sub. H.B. 119 with exceptions noted:

A. SF-3

- 1. ADM data is based on a projected October count ADM as prepared for the budget. These estimates are used for both the October and February count; as such, the ADM values may be slightly overstated.
- 2. GAP aid calculations have not been updated. The amount paid in the June #2 SF3 was used for the July #1 payment.
- 3. Base Cost funding includes poverty based assistance (PBA) and parity aid and is used to calculate the state share percentage.
- 4. The charge-off will be applied to the sum of formula aid, PBA and parity aid. However, the calculation of base cost funding did not include this change for the July #1. Once completed, poverty based assistance, parity aid, and the state share percentage for some districts will be reduced.
- 5. The formula aid amount is \$5,565.
- 6. Special Education weights remain at F2007 levels (90% of the statutory level.)
- 7. The hourly rate for PBA intervention funding is \$21.01.
- 8. PBA teacher professional development, dropout prevention and community outreach are fully funded (the 70% phase-in has been removed.)
- 9. Closing the Achievement gap funding in PBA has been calculated based on the building data for the 2005-2006 school year. The funding will be updated with school year 2006-2007 data when it becomes available in August.
- 10. The cost of doing business factor (COBD) has been removed from current year calculations.
- 11. Regular Transportation is being paid at 101% of the previous year's amount.
- 12. Special Education Transportation will be paid at F2007 levels until current year data is available.
- 13. PBA class size reduction funding has been renamed to "increased learning opportunity" and the salary allowance is \$56,754.
- 14. Units' years of experience has been increased by 1.
- 15. The formula aid, reappraisal, and PBA guarantees have been eliminated.
- 16. Tax year 2006 valuation figures used.



B. Statement of Settlement

1. PBA is no longer restricted for districts who receive less than \$10,000 annually. A line has been added to the Unrestricted Aid section to reflect unrestricted PBA funds; however, the unrestricted amounts will not appear on this line until the July #2 payment.

C. ESC Notes

- 1. Early childhood and gifted have been broken into separate lines on the J40404 report and the statement of settlement.
- 2. State per pupil amount of \$37.00/\$40.52 for multi-county ESC's paid @ 100% for locals, 99.90129% for cities/exempted villages, and 0.00% for community schools.
- 3. Based on FY2007 EMIS data with the noted following exceptions:
 - a. Units years of experience increased by 1.
- 4. J40404 K-12 ADM is based on FY2007 ADM projected for FY2008.

The calculation is as follows:

Current Year Formula ADM

- + SF3 Total Kindergarten * .5
- + Pre-school ADM attending the Educational Service Center
- + SF3 JVSD-1-12 * .80
- + SF3 JVSD-SE-1-12 * .80
