This payment reflects the factors based on Am. Sub. H.B. 119.

A. SF-3

1. Preschool handicapped units were funded at 99.911474 % to stay within appropriations.

B. Statement of Settlement

1. Supplements for FY 2009 Gifted Identification (499-3219) (JV75) have been released for payment. This funding is for restricted fund 499 use only. The Gifted ID payment is released with the submittal and approval of the FY2008 final expenditure reports (FER) based on the schedule provided by the Office of Exceptional Children. Use receipt code 3219.
2. SF14 tuition adjustments for non-handicapped pupils are included in this payment (JV50, JV51) and SF14 H tuition adjustments for handicapped pupils are also included in this payment (JV52, JV53).
3. Gifted special projects payments are included in this payment (JV77)
4. A FY 2008 Final #4 (JV32) was run with this payment to adjust the FY 2008 SF-3 payment for 1) open enrollment adjustments; 2) a correction in the carryover property values used in the calculation of recognized valuation; 3) updates in the Autism Scholarship deduction and FTEs; and 4) final FTE calculations for community schools.

C. ESC

1. The state per pupil amount of \$37.00/\$40.52 is calculated at 100% for pupils from locals, cities, exempted villages and community school pupils. Subsequently, a budget reduction of \$5,000,000 per executive order 2008-01S was applied reducing each ESC's annual amount by approximately 9.475073 % of the calculated total.
2. Preschool handicapped units were funded at 99.911474 % to stay within appropriations.

3. A FY 2008 Final #4 was run with this payment to make very slight adjustments caused by the adjustments in the Final #4 SF-3 for regular school districts. (JV30)

D. MRDD

1. Preschool handicapped units were funded at 99.911474 % to stay within appropriations.
2. A FY 2008 Final #4 (JV31) was run with this payment to account for a correction in the guarantee calculation that was a processing error and changes in unit funding percentages caused by changes for city, exempted village and local districts.
