***CHERRIES in CHERRY GELATIN
SHELF STABLE CUPS
(OHIO PROCESSED)***

Product Description

Individually packaged 4oz. cups of cherries in cherry gelatin using USDA fruit. Gelatin is not pork based.

Pack Size

Cherries in cherry gelatin cups are packaged seventy-two (72)-4oz. cups per shipping carton. Each case weights 24 lbs.

Yield

Each fruit cup will provide ½ cup fruit/vegetable credit in the National School Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program.

Uses

Cherries in cherry gelatin cups may be served in the breakfast program or the lunch program.

Storage

Cherries in cherry gelatin cups are shelf stable. The product may be stored between 45° - 80°F for up to eighteen (18) months. Product should **never** be frozen.

Best If Used By*

Fruit cups are best if used within six (6) months of receipt.

Preparation

Cherries in cherry gelatin cups are ready to serve.
