



CAMEO APPLE

The cameo apple is a relatively new kind of apple having only been introduced in 1998. Believed to a relative of the red and golden delicious apple, cameo apples that come out of Washington State are regulated by the Cameo Apple Marketing Association. In order to be considered a cameo, these apples must meet a list of standards based upon taste, texture and color.

The cameo apple is super-sweet and super-crunchy. It has a creamy yellow skin and is covered in red stripes. The red stripes develop just prior to the apple being ready for harvest. By picking the apple as soon as they develop this striping it ensures the skin maintains the thin and delicate texture the cameo is known for. Cameo apples are available year round for us to enjoy.
