

# **Community Eligibility Option (CEO) Fact Sheet**

#### What is CEO?

SFA's agree to serve no cost lunches and no cost breakfasts to all students for up to four consecutive years in approved schools.

As of April 1, 2013 determine the school(s) has a minimum of 40% "identified" students based on enrollment (not free and reduced count).

School eligibility is based on the number of students who meet the "identified" definition:

- Certified free using methods other than a paper free and reduced meal application. These include students who are:
- Directly certified for free meals on the basis of their participation in the Supplemental Nutrition
  Assistance Program (SNAP) or Ohio Works First (OWF) and the extension of benefits to students
  within the same household. Homeless, Runaway, Migrant, Head Start, or Foster children with court
  papers.

#### **Benefits of CEO:**

- An innovative option to reduce administrative paperwork and costs, while making it easier for eligible children in low-income communities to receive free meals in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs.
- May improve breakfast and lunch participation.
- If school district is participating in CEO district wide, the school district will not need to do verification, but will need to fill out CRRS verification report annually. If only a portion of the schools participate in CEO, the district will do verification for the schools not participating in CEO, and fill out the CRRS verification report annually.

- E. Notification from ODE to new applicant's eligibility into the CEO option will arrive via email, approximately within 30 days of receipt of your CEO worksheet and form, if eligible and completed correctly.

## F. After submission to ODE to apply for CEO: Next Steps

- LEAS that have elected to participate in CEO for at least one site must notify households of children attending the CEO school(s) of CEO participation in the 2013-2014 school year. LEAs may use this sample household letter to serve as the required notification.

## G. How to figure out if a district is eligible to apply for CEO?

- This calculator tool allows schools that are considering the Community Eligibility Option (CEO) to calculate their estimated federal reimbursement they will receive as to assess the financial viability of their school meal program under CEO.
