



Parent Checklist for Visiting Providers

Choosing a provider for your child is a difficult and important decision. During your visit, it is important that you have all the information that you need to make that decision. You can make copies of this checklist to take to each school or service provider that you visit. Please consider asking about the following:

Provider Name, Contact Name, Phone, Is your Program a School?

Number of Students, Average group size, Type of special education services, Admission Requirements?

Volunteering or Fundraising?, Discipline?, Religious Expectations?, Attendance?

Table with columns: Tuition and Fees, Yes/No checkboxes, and dollar amounts for Tuition, Application, Registration, Enrollment, Books/Supplies, Uniforms.

Table with columns: Services, Yes/No checkboxes, and dollar amounts for Intervention, Speech, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Aide, Other.

Table with columns: Other Costs, Yes/No checkboxes, and dollar amounts for Transportation, Special Education, Financial Aid, Tutoring, Breakfast, Lunch.

Table with columns: Other Costs, Yes/No checkboxes, and dollar amounts for Before/After Care, Sports, Music, Art, Clubs, Field Trips.

Notes:

The scholarship can only be used to pay for tuition and special education services at registered providers. All other costs are the responsibility of the parent. Each provider is required to give you their tuition and fee schedule.

You should be prepared to provide the following information to the provider: birth certificate, proof of your address (copy of recent utility bill), report cards and/ or test records from your child's previous school. A scholarship application form can be obtained from the provider.
