**Description of how student instructional needs will be determined and documented:**

Ansonia Local School's Remote Learning Plan will provide online, self-guided instruction for students in grades K - 12. Ansonia Local Schools will be working with Montgomery County ESC to provide remote instruction, through SchoolsPLP. Students selecting this option were given the option of attending school in session or remote learning option. Parents selecting the remote learning option were contacted by the building principal to ensure expectations of remote learning were understood. SchoolsPLP instructors will use both formative and summative assessments to inform instruction and assure mastery of content.

**Method for determining competency, granting credit, and promoting students:**

Assessments and assignments which measure students' mastery of core concepts and standards will be used to determine competency in the Ohio Learning Standards. Grades will be awarded based on the grading scale and grading policy. Final grade for each course will be recorded on the student's official transcript. A failing grade will be recorded for each course NOT completed at the end of each semester. Students that pass their course will be promoted to the next semester/grade level.

**Attendance and Participation Requirements:**

School attendance will be documented regularly in accordance with Ansonia Local Schools Attendance Policy. Students are required to access their courses regularly on a daily basis (Monday - Friday). Engagement will be monitored through assigned lessons and completion of assignments. SchoolsPLP will also monitor attendance and completion of assignments through their instructor and track progress online. SchoolsPLP will document time logged and engagement.

**How student progress will be monitored:**

Teachers, students, and parents will be able to track progress through the SchoolsPLP website. Each student and parent will have access to the website to track progress and completion of assignments.

**How equitable access to quality instructions will be ensured:**

All remote learners will have access to a school issued computer to complete their online instruction. All appropriate service and accommodations will be provided to students with disabilities according to their IEP while at a remote setting. All efforts will be made to meet the students' individual needs for intervention and services while in a remote setting. SchoolsPLP curriculum is aligned to the Ohio Learning Standards.

**Professional development opportunities offered to teachers:**

Professional development will be provided by Ansonia Local Schools for online learning. Training will be provided in Google: Classroom, Forms, Drive, Slides, Meet, and Quizzes. SchoolsPLP will also provide training for staff on monitoring student progress.
