Description of how student instructional needs will be determined and documented:

Arcanum-Butler's Remote Learning Plan (RLP), will provide online, self-guided, instruction for students in grades K-12. Students will access Edgenuity's online platform to complete work and communicate with Ohio certified teachers. Individual student instructional needs will be determined by school administration upon completion of the online student enrollment form. Weekly progress reports will document student time online and assignments completed. Final grades will be issued at the end of each semester.

Method for determining competency, granting credit, and promoting students:

- The final grade for each course will be recorded on the student's official transcript.
- A failing grade will be recorded for each course NOT completed at the end of each semester.
- Students that pass their courses will be promoted to the next semester/grade level.

Attendance requirements, including how participation in learning opportunities will be documented:

Remote learning will require the same commitment as the traditional classroom. 5-7 hours of online work (Monday-Friday) should be the expected norm.

Remote learning attendance policies adopted by the Board of Education state:

When a student fails to log in for **10** consecutive days without a written and properly signed doctor's note, he/she is placed on attendance probation and must have a doctor's note for any further absences.

When a student fails to log in for **15** consecutive days without written and properly signed doctor's note, a notice will be sent to the Darke County School Attendance Officer with the Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Division. Furthermore, failure to comply with the remote learning attendance procedures may result in dismissal from the program.

All learning opportunities, student/teacher contacts, and time logged are documented by Edgenuity.

How students progress will be monitored:

Students will be monitored daily by their online teacher(s) and the director of remote learning. Progress on the completion of assignments is available through the use of the platform and reports will be emailed to parents and students weekly.

How equitable access to quality instruction will be ensured:

All remote learners will have access to a school-issued computer, and internet access will be provided if it is not currently available to the student. Accommodations will be made when necessary to meet individual student's needs. Edgenuity's online curriculum is aligned with state standards.

Professional development opportunities offered to teachers:

Edgenuity will provide ongoing professional development opportunities for the Arcanum-Butler staff. Activities include: best use of resources, utilization of technology, monitoring student progress, and providing additional student supports.
