SCHOOL DISTRICT REMOTE LEARNING PLAN

In accordance with Section 16 of Sub. H.B. 164 of the 133rd General Assembly the below information addresses the checklist provided by the Ohio Department of Education for Blanchester Local School District's Remote Learning Plan. General information, Parent/Guardian, and Student Expectations for the learning plan are listed in the District's Reopening Guide under "Distance Learning."

1. Instructional needs will be determined by daily progress monitoring and completion of assignments. Teachers will host Google Meets with their students a minimum of two (2) times weekly and all Google Meets will be recorded and shared in Google Classroom. Teachers will have two (2) hours of office hours available for students each day.
2. Method to be used for determining competency, granting credit and promoting students to higher grade level will through Google Meets and Google Classroom. The same "in-person" (State supported curriculum) will be the taught curriculum.
3. Attendance requirements, including how the school will document participating in learning opportunities will be measured by requiring students to login to Google Classroom daily for assignments and complete those assignments.
4. Student's progress will be monitored by teachers posting a minimum of two (2) grades weekly in Progress Book. Grades can also be feedback on progress, not always finished products.
5. Equitable access to quality instruction will be ensured by recording and sharing Google Meets in Google Classroom. Teachers will be given two (2) office hours a day for teacher/student communication.
6. Professional Development will be offered to teachers prior to school reopening and throughout the school year. Topic covered during the professional development will be Google Classroom, Google Meets, Google Class Tag, Gifted training, setting expectations for parents, students, and staff.
