

East Knox Local Schools 2020-2021 Remote Learning Plan

1. Student Instructional needs will be determined and documented by the following:
 - a. Formative assessments
 - b. Summative assessments
 - c. Weekly assignments
2. Student mastery level will be determined by:
 - a. Formative and summative assessments
3. Credits will be awarded to students who show proficiency in the standards and they will be promoted to a higher grade level per board policy.
4. Attendance Policy
 - a. On campus learning - students are expected to be on campus per board adopted calendar and must submit work to the teacher as directed. Normal attendance policies apply.
 - b. Off campus remote learning - Students must submit work as directed; completed work denotes attendance.
5. Student Progress will be monitored with:
 - a. Formative assessments
 - b. Weekly assignments
6. Students will have equitable access to quality instruction through use of:
 - a. Normal on-campus resources for in-class instruction
 - b. District supplied technology (i.e. Chromebook or iPad) as needed and approved
 - c. Access to teachers during scheduled school days
 - d. Common online standards based curriculum
7. Teacher professional development will include:
 - a. Review COVID symptoms and protocols
 - b. Required annual trainings (i.e. Blood borne pathogens, etc.) through Public School Works
 - c. Training for SPED teachers as needed
 - d. Training in Apex and Edgenuity online learning platforms to those affected.
