- By teachers via data from formative and summative assignments, activities, assessments and benchmarks

- We will use the current policies and protocol already established and in place for granting credit and promoting students to higher grade levels, all of which consider students' exceptional needs (IEP, 504, EL, gifted). Teachers use formative and summative assessments to determine competency.

- We will use the current policy, resources and protocol in place for tracking daily attendance. Specifically, we will use the attendance component of GradeBook and DASL.
