Provide a description of how student instructional needs will be determined and documented

The Schnee Learning Center will continue to follow the education plan as detailed in its community school sponsor contract and in compliance with ORC 3314.03 to meet our students' instructional needs. As indicated in the school's education plan and alternative re-opening plan, Ohio Learning Standard-aligned local assessments, teacher-developed criteria, referenced diagnostic, and both formative and summative assessments will be used to ensure student instructional needs are being met.

Describe the method to be used for determining competency, granting credit and promoting students to higher grade level

As required by ORC 3314.03, the Schnee Learning Center will continue to utilize the methods described in the school's alternative re-opening plan and its community school contract educational plan.

Include the school's attendance requirements, including how the school will document participation in learning opportunities

Attendance will be monitored and documented in compliance with the school's policy. During periods of remote learning, attendance will be determined based upon participation in learning opportunities and through staff and teacher communications with students. Teachers will utilize a variety of communication methods to engage students and families throughout remote learning periods. These methods include, but are not limited to, U.S. postal mail, e-mail, text messaging, Google Classroom, Google Meets, various video conferencing platforms, telephone calls, and face-to-face communications.

Learning opportunities, completion of assignments, and student engagement through various methods (both electronic and face-to-face) will be tracked and documented weekly by the teachers and staff as indicated in Schnee Learning Center's plan.



Provide a statement describing how student progress will be monitored

Schnee Learning Center will continue to monitor student progress pursuant to the school's educational plan, alternative re-opening plan, and board approved policies. During periods of remote learning, teachers will work with students and assess student work. Teachers will monitor student engagement and assess individual learning, progress, and performance during these periods. Teachers will document performance as indicated in the school's plan.

Provide a description as to how equitable access to quality instruction will be ensured

Schnee Learning Center will continue to follow its community school contract education plan, alternative re-opening plan, and equity plan. The methods of delivery of instruction will be based upon individualized student needs, circumstances, parent/guardian/student choice, and Ohio Learning Standards- aligned course content. Teachers, including Intervention Specialists, will assess students to determine whether additional supports are needed throughout periods of remote learning. During periods of remote learning, a variety of delivery methods may be used including, but not limited to: Independent study, project-based learning, learning activity packets, credit flexibility, research projects, cross-grade grouping, cross-curricular projects, cooperative learning, work-based learning, television, podcasts, film, video, Edmentum Plato online curriculum, Newsela non-fiction cross-curricular online curriculum, or other methods as determined by teaching staff and school administration to meet student needs.

Provide a description of the professional development activities that will be offered to teachers

Schnee Learning Center will continue to provide professional development for teachers according to its planned professional development calendar. Additional professional development will be provided in COVID-19 education and safety procedures, Google Classroom, use of document cameras, literacy online across-the-curriculum, and other opportunities available based upon feedback from the building leadership team, teacher-based teams, and individual teacher requests. Teachers will be provided professional development to assist with remote learning topics. Professional development delivery may include face-to-face workshops, online courses, and collaborative workshops with teacher-based teams.

The School continues to comply with requirements otherwise prescribed under continuing law regarding a minimum number of school hours and state funding.
