

**Wyoming City Schools  
Remote Learning Plan  
2020-2021**

***A description of how student instructional needs will be determined and documented:***

Wyoming City Schools will use a variety of formal and informal assessments to determine the instructional needs of our students. MAP assessment data will be used in grades K-8, and standards aligned assessments in grades 9-12. Combined with regular informal assessments, staff will use this data to ensure student needs are identified and met.

***The method to be used of determining competency, granting credit, and promoting students to a higher grade level:***

Students will be instructed by Wyoming City Schools covering the same content as a traditional in-person setting. Traditional grading scales will be utilized, and credit will be granted for students receiving passing grades. Students will be promoted according to our existing board policy.

***The school's attendance requirements, including how the school will document participation in learning opportunities:***

Regular student attendance will be expected and monitored by staff and recorded through our Student Information System (SIS). Students will have dedicated staff members to monitor attendance. Teachers will be responsible for documenting attendance and participation. Each building has designated remote check-in staff, along with building counselors and administration, that are responsible for contacting families should students show signs of non-participation.

***A statement describing how students progress will be monitoring:***

All students will be working with Wyoming teachers who will interact with students on a daily basis; just like in a typical in-person school day, new lessons and activities will be covered during class. Student progress will be monitored through formal and informal assessments. Staff will regularly monitor student progress and provide regular feedback and intervention as needed based on student needs.

***A description as to how equitable access to quality instruction will be ensured:***

All students will have access to a district owned device. The district will work with families that don't have at-home wireless access to ensure that they are provided connection. Regardless of the model employed, Wyoming staff will be directly involved with all students.

***A description of the professional development activities that will be offered to teachers:***

Wyoming City Schools has employed a technology instructional coach to provide ongoing support to all staff. The previous and on-going focus of professional development has been around instructional tools and strategies to maximize the effectiveness of remote instruction.
