

Section Criteria for the 2014 State Superintendent's Schools of Promise

All public elementary and secondary schools administering Ohio Achievement and Ohio Graduation Tests were considered for the award, were selected based on the following criteria for the 2013-2014 school year:

Poverty Rate: The school served 40 percent or more economically disadvantaged students, as reported in EMIS for the 2013-2014 school year.

AMO Grade (must have a letter grade): A or B

Student Performance on Ohio Achievement Tests and Ohio Graduation Tests in reading and mathematics in each tested grade level (3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 10) for the 2013-2014 school year:

All Students Group: 80 percent or greater proficiency ***Low-***

Income Subgroup: 80 percent or greater proficiency

Racial/Ethnic Subgroups: 80 percent or greater proficiency

Note: When evaluating test results, only subgroups with 10 or more tests takers in a particular subject and grade level were considered. Subgroups with fewer than 10 students were not measured against the 80 percent standard.

Progress Grade, *if applicable:* A, B, or C

Graduation Rate Grade, *if applicable:* A or B
