



### **Section Criteria for the 2013 High Progress Schools of Honor**

All public elementary and secondary schools administering Ohio Achievement and Ohio Graduation Tests were considered for the award, and selected based on the following criteria:

**Title 1 Status:** Title I recipient or Title I-eligible

**Poverty Rate:** The school served 40 percent or more economically disadvantaged students, as reported in EMIS for the 2012-2013 school year

**Gains in Student Performance on Ohio Achievement and Ohio Graduation Tests over a Five Year Period (2009 through 2013 school years):** The school's gains in its combined reading and math proficiency over the past five years (between 2009 and 2013) must meet or exceed the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile of all statewide gains. (Subject results are combined and aggregated for grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10.)

**Gains in Graduation Rate over a Five Year Period, *if applicable*:** The school's gains in its legacy graduation rate over the past five years (between 2008 and 2012) must meet or exceed the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile of all statewide gains in graduation.

**Progress Grade, *if applicable*:** Must meet or exceeded this measure for the three most recent years for which the school has data. In 2010-2011 and 2011-2012 school years, value added must have been "Met" or "Above." In 2012-2013 the progress grade must be an A, B, or C.

**AMO Grade:** A, B, or C for the 2012-2013 school year
