  - d. Interventions and learning supports
  - e. The school's budget
- 2. Beyond the OAA and OGT, what standardized and non-standardized assessments are used in your school?
- 3. What do you expect to see going on in your classrooms?
- 4. How frequently are non-academic student data reviewed by your staff?
- 5. Describe your school's interventions and learning supports. What in-class and out-of-class intervention supports are in place?
- 6. What supports does your school provide to parents and the community to ensure active home partnership?
- 7. Describe the professional development currently taking place.
- 8. How does your school evaluate the effectiveness of its programs, activities, practices and allocation of resources?
- 9. In what ways does the district central office/school board support or hinder your school's ability to improve student performance and operate as effective partners?
