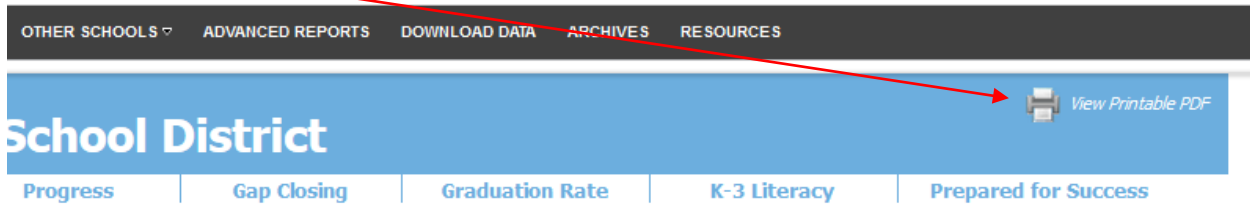


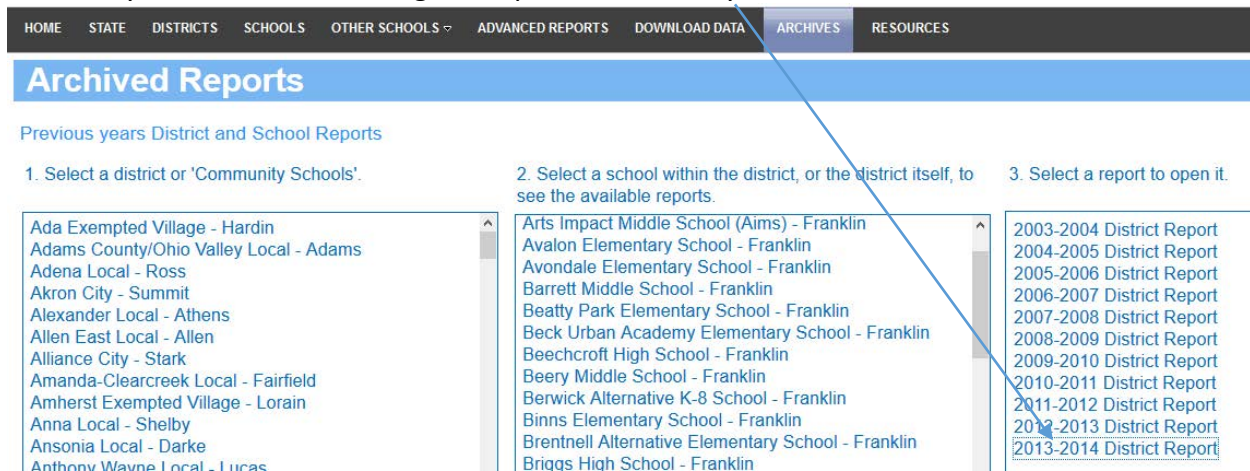
## Progress

A quick way to gather district or building progress data is to go to the ODE website and open the Ohio Report Card

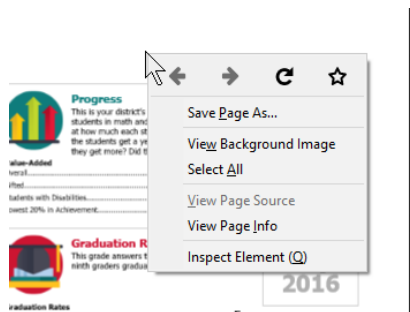
- a. Click “View Printable PDF” to generate and save the current report card.



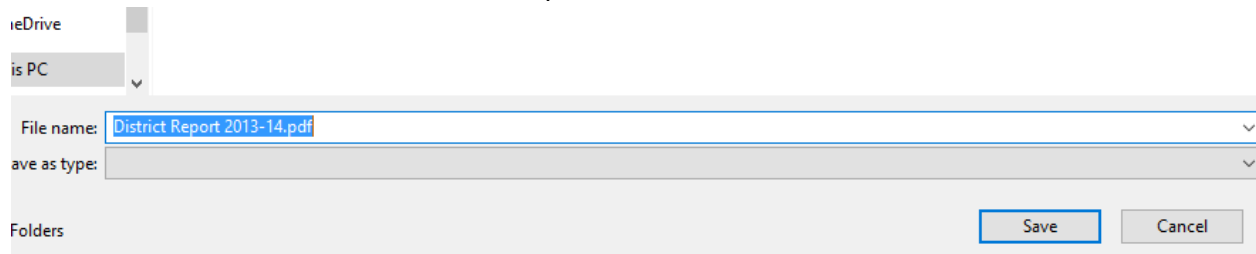
- b. Open the file and copy the progress data.
- c. If you want to analyze previous years report card data click the Ohio Report Card ARCHIVES tab.
- d. Select your district or building and a previous school year.



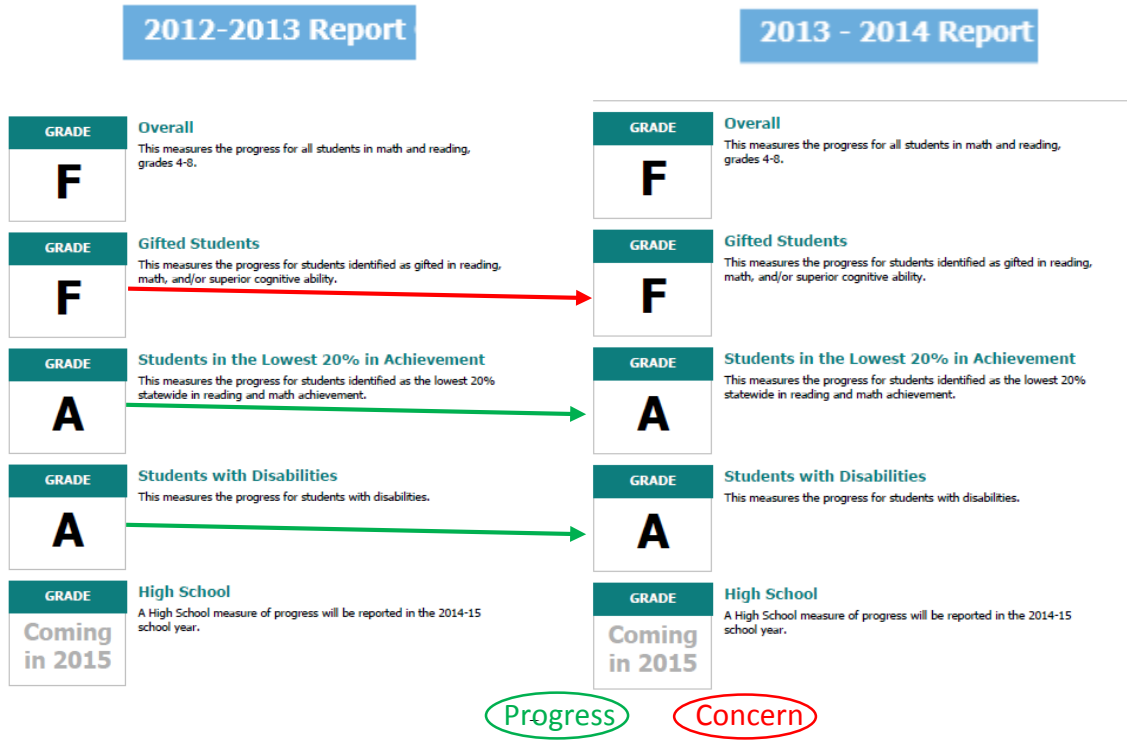
- e. Right click and select “Save Page As”



f. Enter a file name and, if needed, add .pdf to the end of the file name and **Click Save**.



g. Open the .pdf and copy the progress data items.
