

Innovative Education Pilot Program Waiver Application Checklist 2013-2014 School Year



The waiver application will only be accepted if the necessary documents accompany it.

IPP Waiver Application Checklist for all applications:

- Completed application form
- Letter of support or resolution signed by the local school board president or treasurer
- Letter of support signed by the local superintendent/building leader
- Letter of support signed by the professional staff bargaining unit leader

If your district has previously been granted an IPP waiver:

- End of Year Report for the most recently approved waiver days

If the district is NOT a part of Race to the Top or SIG:

- Summary (no more than two pages) describing the proposed innovative education pilot program. Summaries longer than two pages will not be accepted.

Submit applications and accompanying documents to IPPWaivers@education.ohio.gov at least 45 days prior to the requested effective date but no later than December 31, 2013.
