

Sample Board Policy

The Provision of FAPE to Children in Juvenile Detention Centers and Community Corrections Facilities

The Board of Education is committed to providing a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (IDEA) to children between ages three and 21 who are (1) eligible for special education and related services under the IDEA and (2) whose school district of residence is the **[INSERT]** School District pursuant to OAC 3301-51-01(A)(2)(a). The Board of Education recognizes that the obligation to provide FAPE includes the provision of FAPE to children who are being held or have been court ordered to juvenile detention centers or children who have been committed to community correctional facilities. Accordingly, the Board authorizes the Superintendent to develop procedures in the Administrative Guidelines to implement this policy and ensure that such children receive FAPE.
