Our Program

- ▶ 28 Sites - All Outside
- ▶ 32 Employees - Average 4 hours per day
- ▶ 1,500 Daily Participation
- ▶ Meals prepared at one central kitchen (hot and cold)
- ▶ Sites are located at schools, churches, library, YMCA, parking lots, swimming pool, apartment complexes and mobile feeding bus
- ▶ Weekend meal program distributes 2,000 bags per week

Site Selection

- ▶ Survey families before school is out to see where they would go
- ▶ Find out about summer camps and VBS or day cares
- ▶ Community events, food pantries, farmers markets, pools, recs, fairs

Site Time

- ▶ Half hour to 45 minutes.
- ▶ Get signage at the site out one week ahead with the site times on it.
- ▶ Coordinate sites so that workers can work more than one site.

Workers

- ▶ Two per site, working 4 hours per day
- ▶ 16 years and up
- ▶ Prefer college students to encourage participation
- ▶ School employees are hired under a supplemental contract (no benefits)
- ▶ Will workers use their own vehicles to transport food?
- ▶ Serve Safe Certified?

Food

- ▶ Serve a variety of hot and cold
- ▶ Branding works! Domino's Pizza is our biggest day
- ▶ Freeze milk in hot weather
- ▶ Rice bags warmers in insulated bags
- ▶ Pre package everything for ease of service
- ▶ Can you store shelf stable items at the site?
