WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR REPORTING RESTRAINT AND SECLUSION DATA?

Ohio <u>rule</u> requires districts to annually report information regarding the use of restraint and seclusion to the Department. The district providing direct educational services to the student should document, review and report incidents of restraint and seclusion. However, there are scenarios where reporting requirements may vary. The chart below explains which entities are responsible for reporting.
