Modeled after the Stanford 10, Aprenda 3 assesses Spanish-speaking students’ school achievement in reading, mathematics, language, spelling, science, social science, and listening comprehension, for Kindergarten through Grade 12. Aprenda is available as a paper-and-pencil assessment.

Aprenda 3 consists of a battery of 12 test levels that assess students from Kindergarten through Grade 12. Aprenda 3 measures the important instructional standards of the curricula from the second half of Kindergarten through the end of grade 9. At the high school levels, where Aprenda Avanzado 1 and 2 levels assess basic skills, a single level is appropriate for use in spring of the same school year and fall of the next year.

Aprenda 3 is designed to measure growth and achievement. Reports include the Home Report in Spanish and intended for parents; the Student Report with Clusters; and the Student Performance Standards Report. Sample reports may be viewed at this url:
