Ohio Career-Technical Education Teacher Licensure

Purpose

The *Ohio Career-Technical Teacher Licensure Overview* is designed to assist administrators (superintendents, principals, directors) with recruiting, hiring and retaining teachers of career-technical programs, particularly those at the high school level.

This resource supplements more detailed information in the *Teacher Education and Licensure Standards* and the *Guide for Licensing Candidates for Career-Technical Education in Ohio*, accessible at education.ohio.gov.

Contents

The *Overview* includes:

- ▶ Flow charts showing differences and similarities as well as required steps in three paths of recruitment and retention of career-technical education teachers;
- ▶ Selected definitions of terminology within the career-technical education licensure structure; and
- ▶ List of Ohio universities that are approved to offer courses and programs to help career-technical teachers obtain, expand and renew licenses.

Selected Definitions

- ▶ **CTE-36** – Career-Technical Education (CTE) qualification form to determine applicability of Alternative Resident Educator candidate credentials to position being sought.
- ▶ **CTE-37** – Teacher license verification form for Alternative Resident Educator candidates and Supplemental candidates.
- ▶ **License** – Document issued by the State Board of Education to an individual who is deemed to be qualified to teach or practice in Ohio schools. Ohio has Resident Educator, Alternative Resident Educator, Supplemental and Professional (five-year) licenses.
- ▶ **Panel of experts** – Minimum of three individuals from business and industry who are currently active in the career or career field for which the Alternative Resident Educator or Supplemental license candidate is being assessed (postsecondary representative recommended).
