

**EDUCATOR STANDARDS BOARD
NOMINATION PROCESS
FACT SHEET**

Membership:

Senate Bill 2 and House Bill 1 provide that the Educator Standards Board (ESB) shall have 21 voting, with 18 members appointed by the State Board of Education with sixty days of the effective date of the law. The Senate Bill 2 and House Bill 1 also provides that there shall be six non-voting, ex-officio members of the ESB: the Superintendent of Public Instruction or a designee of the superintendent, the Chancellor of the Ohio Department of Higher Education or a designee of the chancellor, the chairperson of the Senate Education Committee, the chairperson of the House of Representatives Education Committee, and the ranking minority members of the education committees of the Senate and House of Representatives. Senate Bill 2 and House Bill 1 prescribe the following makeup of the 21 voting members:

Ten Persons Employed as Teachers in a School District:

- ◆ Three persons employed as teachers in a secondary school
- ◆ Two persons employed as teachers in a middle school
- ◆ Three persons employed as teachers in an elementary school
- ◆ One person employed as a teacher in a pre-K classroom
- ◆ One person who serves as a teacher on a Local Professional Development Committee

(At least one of the persons appointed under this division must be certified by the National Board of Professional Teaching standards.)

One Person Employed as a Teacher in a Chartered Non-Public School:

Five Persons Employed as School Administrators in a School District:

- ◆ One person employed as a secondary school principal
- ◆ One person employed as a middle school principal
- ◆ One person employed as an elementary school principal
- ◆ One person employed as a school district superintendent
- ◆ One person employed as a school treasurer or business manager

One Person who is a Member of a School District Board of Education:

One Person who is a Member of the Parent Teacher Association

Three Persons Employed by Institutions of Higher Education That Offer Teacher Education Programs Approved under 3345.011 are appointed by the Chancellor of the Ohio Department of Higher Education:

- ◆ One person employed in a private institution
- ◆ One person employed in a state university or university branch
- ◆ One person employed by a state community college, community college, or technical college

(Of the two persons employed in the four year institutions, one shall be employed in a college of education and one shall be employed in a college of arts and sciences)
